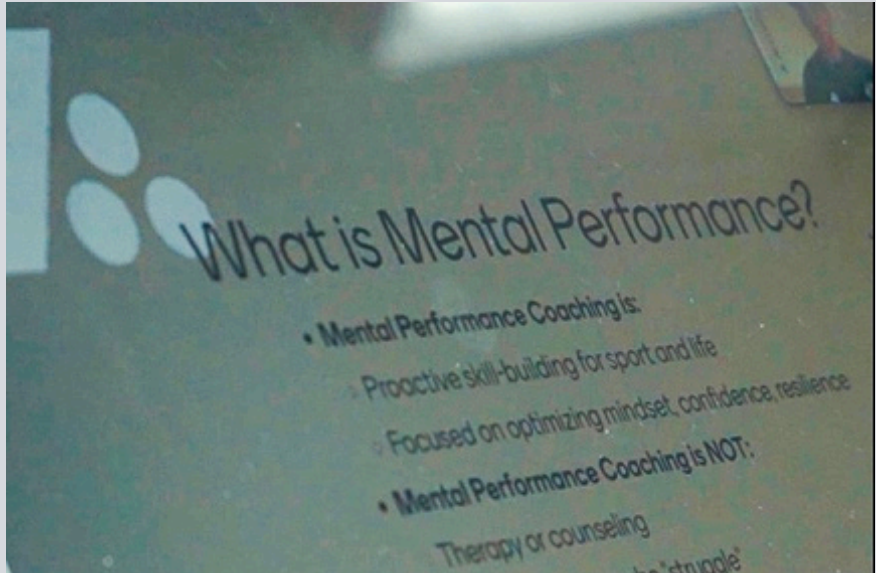

Buy a Yearbook!

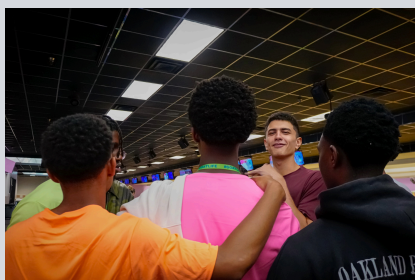
